PERPETUAL EDUCATION FUND lds.org/pef

Directed through the Church Institute Program, the PEF provides loans, with minimal interest, to be repaid once recipients have completed their education and are gainfully employed.

Announced by Pres. Hinckley in 2001; funded completely by contributions. It benefits primarily returned missionaries from underdeveloped areas who often return to a life of poverty after Church service, lacking the resources to pay for an education.

PEF is an educational opportunity and a revolving resource, as was the Perpetual Emigration Fund, where money is loaned, repaid and then loaned again to others in need.
